Report any concerns immediately to a trusted adult at home or school, Childline, NSPCC, CEOP or police.



#### educate & empower

Educate others on the signs of grooming and exploitation. Be empowered to act on concerns.



#### communicate

Communicate with your friends to encourage them to talk about online concerns and ensure everyone looks out for one another.
